

Call for nominations for Journal of Intercultural Communication Research Editor:

On January 1, 2005, Jim Neuliep began a three-year term as editor of the WCA journal, Journal of Intercultural Communication Research. As many of you know, there are time-consuming details involved in assuming an editorship and initiating a first issue. Jim McCroskey, outgoing JICR editor, worked with Jim Neuliep in order to make the transitional a successful one. I'm sure that all WCA members will agree that under Jim's editorship, especially through his work with Taylor and Francis during these past three years, that the JICR is increasingly being recognized as one of the top-quality Journals in this field.

In order to provide an ample transition period for the next editor, a search is continuing with this Call for Jim Neuliep's successor.

1. A letter of interest that includes a statement of the direction they would like to see the journal take under their editorship,
2. a resume, and
3. a letter of support from their Chair or Dean, indicating the level of support that will be provided by their institution, including secretarial assistance.
